<b>Duties:</b>		
<p>The hospitalists have the responsibility for acute medical care and Intermediate Care. They assess patients both from the outpatient, Urgent Care, and outside medical facilities to evaluate their acute medical problems, admit patients, and treat as necessary. They are responsible for appropriate discharge of patients. They participate in the care of Intermediate Care patients. They may have academic opportunities to work with their and fourth year medical students, medical residents, and allied health students. Rotating weekend rounds are performed approximately every 6 weeks. Staff hospitalists are expected to participate in on call duties for their patients during the week 24 hours per day during week days. Must complete clinical reminders and meet performance measures.</p>
